INSUFFICIENT FUND CHARGE

A \$25.00 charge will be applied to the customer's account when a check rendered for services is returned for insufficient funds.

LATE PAYMENT FEE

A charge of no more than 1 percent per month will be added to water, sewer, and electric bills not paid within 20 days from date of issuance. The late payment charge shall be applied to the total unpaid balance for utility service, including unpaid payment charges. This charge is applicable to all customers.

SEASONAL SERVICE (Mgt-1)

Seasonal customers shall be served at the general service rate (Schedule Mg-1) except that each customer served under this rate shall pay an annual seasonal service charge equal to 12 times the applicable service charge. Water use in any billing period shall be billed at the applicable volume schedule in Mg-1 and the charge added to the annual seasonal service charge.

PUBLIC SERVICE (Mpa-1)

Water used on an intermittent basis for flushing sewers, street sprinkling, flooding skating rinks, etc., shall be metered where meters can be set to measure the service. Where it is impractical to measure the service, an estimate shall be used.

Volume Charge: \$2.75 per 1,000 gallons

BULK WATER (B-1)

All bulk water supplied to fill tank trucks or swimming pools from the water system through hydrants and/or other connections shall be metered.

COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY RATES

Under provisions of 1999 Wisconsin Act 9 and 2005 Wisconsin Act 141, SBU shall charge each customer a low-income assistance and energy efficiency fee. Low-income programs may include assistance to low-income households for weatherization and other energy conservation services, payment of energy bills or early identification and prevention of energy crises. Collections related to energy efficiency are forwarded to the State Focus on Energy program.

Monthly Service Charge:

Residential Service (Rg-1) and Optional TOD (Rg-2):

3.0% of the total electric bill, not to exceed \$1.44

General Service (Gs-1) and Optional TOD (Gs-2):

3.0% of the total electric bill, not to exceed \$2.00

Small Power Service (Cp-1) and Optional TOD (Cp-1 TOD):

3.0% of the total electric bill, not to exceed \$7.50

Large Power TOD Service (Cp-2):

3.0% of the total electric bill, not to exceed \$35.00

Industrial Power TOD Service (Cp-3):

3.0% of the total electric bill, not to exceed \$50.00

REFUSE RATES
